4. Does your Big Idea aim to tackle a social issue? What's the root cause of this problem? How does your idea tackle this root cause? (160 words/7 points)

5. Is your Big Idea of an entrepreneurial nature? Have you considered the market environment where you will have to operate? (120 words/6 points)

6. Describe your long-term desired outcomes. How will you measure your progress toward these outcomes? (240 words/10 points)

7. Innovation is important to Praxis. Explain how your idea is truly innovative. Identify other similar ideas and how your approach is different and has the potential to be more effective. (200 words/10 points)

8. Building a new organisation is challenging. Describe your skills, experience, capabilities and educational qualifications that show your ability to lead a start-up project. How will you ensure sustainability? (360 words/14 points)

9. Why are you uniquely qualified to develop your Big Idea? Describe your experience working with this idea and the community. (240 words/10 points)

10. What resources are currently available to you? Have you fundraised to date?
How experienced are you in managing budgets? (120 words/5 points)
